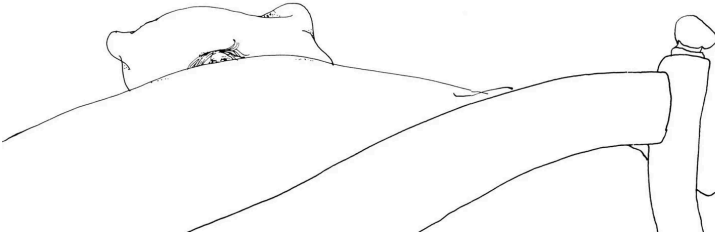


SICK
